Agendas and Agenda Draws

Everyday students write in their agendas as a way of sending parents a message. The message in the lower grades looks a little different than the message the older students write. Whatever age your child is, we ask that you look at the agenda every day and initial it so we know you have seen it. Sometimes there are notes in the front pocket or notes from the teacher. Mrs. Donnelly does

an Agenda Draw everyday. She calls a random name to come down to the office and if their agenda is written in and signed, the student can pick a prize from her prize box. Lately the students have been choosing the knitted/crocheted animals that she is making. Please make sure you are signing your child's agenda every day.

Bullying vs Conflict

Students often think that when there is a disagreement on the playground or in the classroom that the other student is being a bully. Here is some terminology you can use with your child when they are feeling another student is being mean or they feel unheard.

Conflict - Conflict is part of everyday experiences, in which everyone has to deal with experiences that may be unpleasant when we interact with others.

Bullying - When someone is hurt by unwanted words or actions, it usually happens more than once, they have a hard time stopping it from happening again and the other person has some sort of power or control over them.

Dealing with conflict is a skill that everyone needs to learn. Providing your child with some strategies on how to deal with conflict is something we work on at school.

Sometimes students don't tell us when something happens and wait until they get home to say something. If something is happening that we don't know about, please tell us. We are more than willing to help the students deal with these issues.

Shining Star

As part of our 90 Day Plan to ensure that students have a positive self worth, we have started having a Shining Star at morning announcements. Teachers will give student names to Mrs. Donnelly to announce in the mornings along with the reason they have been nominated. This is a good a way for students to feel acknowledged and for them to be proud of themselves. Parents will be notified when their child is a Shining Star.
